

Coeur d'Alene Geographic Area, Current Condition; Aquatic Habitat Condition Map




Figure . Much of the Coeur d'Alene area aquatic habitat has been heavily impacted by past activity. The best existing (most ecologically intact watersheds) shown on this map also have some restoration needs. In addition to best existing condition areas, watersheds with most rehabilitation needs are shown, and the remaining areas are also important to the long term persistence of native fish. "Key life history needs" rivers include the North Fork and Little North Fork Coeur d'Alene River.
